How to Make AI Writing Sound Like You

AI can help you draft and refine your writing, but your judgment, voice, and perspective should shape the final result. Review for accuracy, authenticity, and intent before sharing.



IDEA 01

GIVE AI YOUR VOICE

Describe your audience, purpose, and tone.
Ask AI to preserve your style rather than replace it.

Generic AI Draft: *"I recently visited Rome and had the opportunity to experience its historic landmarks and local culture."* **More Like You:** *"Wandering through Rome, I found a tiny café with the best espresso I've ever had."*

IDEA 02

SIMPLIFY THE LANGUAGE

Shorten overly complex sentences.
Remove filler, jargon, clichés, and exaggerated language.

Generic AI Draft: *"My European adventure included visits to several destinations where I engaged in sightseeing and cultural experiences."* **More Like You:** *"I spent my days exploring Paris, Rome, and Barcelona. Each city felt completely different."*

IDEA 03

ADD WHAT AI DOESN'T KNOW

Add your experiences, observations, opinions, and context.
Use details that make the writing genuinely yours.

Generic AI Draft: *"The view from the Eiffel Tower was impressive."* **More Like You:** *"From the Eiffel Tower, I watched the city light up at sunset. I just stood there and took it in."*

IDEA 04

EDIT FOR AUTHENTICITY

Read the draft as if you were saying it aloud.
Remove phrases you would never use and check facts before sharing.

Generic AI Draft: *"A key highlight of my trip was visiting the Colosseum and learning about its historical significance."* **More Like You:** *"Walking through the Colosseum felt surreal. It made the history feel much more real."*
